

MALAYSIAN RUBBER BOARD (INCORPORATION) ACT 1996

MALAYSIAN RUBBER BOARD (CESS) ORDER 1998

IN exercise of powers conferred by section 37 of the Malaysian Rubber Board (Incorporation) Act 1996 [Act 557], the Minister after consultation with the Minister of Finance makes the following order:

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Malaysian Rubber Board (Cess) Order 1998.

(2) This Order shall come into operation on 1 July 1998.

(3) This Order shall only apply to Peninsular Malaysia.

2. Cess at the rate of 3.85 cents shall be imposed on every kilogramme of natural rubber produced and sold to manufacturers in Peninsular Malaysia.

3. (1) The cess imposed under this Order shall be collected and paid by the seller based on the quantity of natural rubber delivered to the manufacturer.

(2) The seller shall report to the Board any variation between the total quantity of natural rubber contracted for and the total quantity of the natural rubber delivered to the manufacturer.

(3) The seller shall report to the Board all deliveries of local sales of natural rubber during any calendar month not later than the last day of the following month in the manner specified by the Board.

(4) A person who contravenes this paragraph commits an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand ringgit or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both.

4. The seller shall pay the cess collected on natural rubber delivered in any calendar month to the Board not later than the last day of the following month.

RUBBER INDUSTRY (REPLANTING) FUND
ORDINANCE 1952

Rubber Industry (Replanting Fund (Cess On Rubber
Sold To Manufactures) Order 1998

IN exercise of powers conferred by subsection 7(1) of the Rubber Industry (Replanting) Fund Ordinance 1952, The Minister, after consultation with the Minister of Finance makes the following order :

1. This order may be cited as the Rubber Industry (Replanting) Fund (Cess On Rubber Sold To Manufacturers) Order 1998.
2. This Order shall come into operation on 1 July 1998.
3. This Order shall only apply to Peninsular Malaysia.
4. In this Order-

“Board” means the Malaysian Rubber Board established under the Malaysian Rubber Board (Incorporation) Act 1996;

“manufacturer and “seller” mean a manufacturer and a seller licensed under regulation 12 of the Malaysian Rubber Board (Licensing) Regulations 1997.

5. A cess at a rate of 9.92079 cents shall be imposed on every kilogramme of rubber produced and sold to manufacturers in Peninsular Malaysia.

6. (1) The cess imposed under this Order shall be collected by the seller based on the quantity of the rubber sold and delivered to the manufacturer.

(2) The seller shall report to the Board any variation between the total quantity of rubber contracted and the total quantity of the rubber delivered to the manufacturer.

(3) The seller shall report to the Board all deliveries of local sales of rubber in any calendar month specified by the Board.

7. The seller shall pay the cess collected on rubber delivered in any calendar month to the Board before or on the last day of the following month.
